STUDENTS WILL DESIGN AND CREATE A HANDMADE HARDCOVER BOOK USING THE FOLLOWING SPECS:

Quantity: 1

Page count: TBD by Designer

Size: Front and Back Cover: designed 12.5 x 10 inches; 10.5 x 8 live area

Cover: Chipboard that is covered

Interior pages: select a paper stock that is laser or inkjet friendly

File format: Format of book should be designed in InDesign

Binding: Side biding technique (hard cover)
